GROSSE POINTE, Mich., May 16, 2016 – The 2016 Music on the Plaza series, presented by St. John Hospital & Medical Center, invites the public to "Get Jazzed in Grosse Pointe" on Thursday nights with eight free jazz concerts. The "Music on the Plaza" jazz concert series begins June 9, 2016 in downtown Grosse Pointe with performances by the award-winning jazz bands from Grosse Pointe's public high schools.

The Music on the Plaza jazz concert series is produced by the Grosse Pointe Village Downtown Development Authority with support from individuals and organizations of the community. Celebrating its 29th year, the series features a line-up filled with many of the best loved and most talented artists in Detroit's music community.

Concerts take place on Thursday evenings from June 9-August 4 on an outdoor stage, located at the corner of Kercheval Avenue and St. Clair Avenue, from 7 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. There will be no concert on July 28 in order to accommodate The Village Sidewalk Sale, which takes place Friday, July 29 and Saturday, July 30.

The Music on the Plaza series of eight family friendly concerts are free of charge and open to the public. Concert-goers are encouraged to bring lawn chairs. The performances take place, rain or shine. In the event of rain, the concerts will be held at Maire Elementary School, 740 Cadieux Road, two blocks west from the normal site.
