These are the words of Jenna Dell, our Modern Worship Leader, and our new Creative Communications Coordinator. She was baptized at

LSC just over 20 years ago, and has remained since, growing up right in front of our eyes. Earlier this May she graduated from Wayne State University with a major in Music Business & minor in Communications.

This happy & sweet little girl with blonde hair was in service every Sunday with her parents and siblings and attended Sunday School and sang in the Children's Choir. As she grew older, she was part of the Youth Group, sang in the adult choir, and eventually worked in the Nursery, volunteered as a Sunday School Leader and now is part of the adult leadership for our Summer Camp program sharing her musical talents and love of Jesus with the youth.

As a teenager Jenna began participating in Worship during the Special Music segment playing the piano and singing. After we came back to attending church post-covid, at the youthful age of 19 she was asked to fill in as our temporary Modern Worship Leader. What started out as an interim position, quickly grew into a permanent one given her beautiful voice, strong organizational and leadership skills, and friendly and welcoming personality. In this role Jenna told me she spends a minimum of 10 hours weekly planning the musical portion of worship service, choosing songs based on the sermon & scripture schedule, scheduling the musicians, and running weekly practice.

In her new role as Creative Communications Coordinator, she has started training with Jeanette Mazmanian, who will retire in December, 2024. Jenna will be responsible for creating the Soundings, our monthly newsletter, the weekly E-Blast, flyers for church events, building up our website and she will also be working on leveraging our social media presence with Pastor Brendan. Her formal education along with her bubbly personality and determination will certainly be an asset to the church staff and the life of our church.

Jenna is excited about her new role on staff and has some great ideas she would like to implement. One idea is going into the St. Clair Shores' high schools to connect with the teenagers and give them an opportunity to get involved here in our tech and musical programs. The students would volunteer their time and gain valuable experience in performing with the band, and in sound engineering, as well as give them an opportunity to learn about Jesus and experience the love of our church community, Jenna sees this as a win-win for both the young people and Lake Shore Church.

The expanded role that Jenna Dell will play at here is an example of the wonderful things that God is doing for us and our local community. We are both thankful to Him and excited to see how the future will unfold.


