Our confirmation program was created several years ago with a "flipping the classroom" model of learning. Confirmation students and covenant partners "learn" through a video that I and some other pastors in the presbytery produced. Then, we all come together for further discussion and interaction.

This is the smallest class we've done since the inception of this program, and because it's small, we've had some tremendous depth of learning. I am so excited for these young people's faith. At Lake Shore Church we say we are passionate about raising this generation in faith and with this confirmation class, I am so hopeful for the church's future.

Please come on Friday June 6th at 7pm to our **Worship Night** themed "Draw Near," as we will all have the opportunity to hear testimony from these confirmands as they reflect on how God has drawn near to them.

Then, in worship on June 22nd, we will receive those who have completed the process and are ready to make their public profess of faith for the first time. For Fallyn, who has become part of our congregation on her own (neither of her parents are involved), it will also be the day of her baptism. We are so excited for all these youth!

Mission Blessings

On Saturday May 10th, mail carriers across the country had their annual "Stamp Out Hunger" food drive. They did double duty that day, delivering our mail and collecting food donations left out by our neighbors. Our food pantry was one of five St.Clair Shores pantries who were given food donations directly from the carriers. We needed to have volunteers at church between 2-5 o'clock to empty mail trucks and bring the food downstairs. When the call went out for volunteers, a crew was quickly assembled. The first two hours were slow, but then at 4pm, the trucks just kept coming! The youth room was full of bags of food!

On Monday after open pantry hours, pantry workers plus more devoted volunteers worked to empty bags, count by weight, sort, and shelve the food. We took a day off to recoup and completed the task Wednesday morning.

St Clair Shores residents donated thousands of pounds of food, mail carriers delivered that food, and our hard working volunteers got that food into our pantry for guests.

We usually do food pickup from the Macomb Food Program twice a month. We will not need to pick up nonperishables for 6 weeks at least!

St Clair Shores residents donated double the food collected in 2024. The Macomb Food Program, at last count, was 50,000 pounds over last year. Here at Lake Shore, we were blessed with 3,962 pounds of food!! So many blessings and thanks to share...to our mail carriers, our friends and neighbors in SCS, volunteers who ran the event at the Post Office, and all our volunteers from our church family who worked so hard on three separate days and probably don't want to see another can of diced tomatoes for a long while! Thank you everyone.
