Information will be shared at our Town Hall Meeting, which will be in-person and on Zoom following worship on Sunday May 2nd at 11:45am. The town meeting will offer more information about our post-COVID worship strategy and how we see a future for a Traditional Service, Modern Service, and digital worship. We will talk about their discernment around staffing and the immediate position we will be hiring: Director for Worship and Digital Outreach. Essentially, this person will oversee our entire worship system. We have already begun to make shifts to prepare for the changes ahead as we seek to better position ourselves to make our worship rich and full of life. We thank God for our members who have been serving in worship as well as all of the emerging leaders who are stepping into new levels of service.

I am so excited for the future of our worshipping life together. I thank God for the way his Spirit is leading us. Thank you for being with us!


