It would be an honor and privilege to me for you to be there, and I promise this is the last one for a while. I will have some family and friends coming into town for it and people from all over the presbytery will participate in the service.



We are an accredited pantry supported by Macomb County Community Services Agency (MCCSA). We are one of 55 MCCSA pantries in Macomb County. We must go through State sponsored food safety class every three years. Also, every volunteer must go through Civil Rights Training every other year.

Our pantry/clothes closet is on the 211 help list. If someone calls 211 for food or clothing, they can be referred to us by zip code. We also advertise our open days on Facebook and on a Free Food Pantries in MI site.

Twice a month we pick up a van full of food from the MCCSA warehouse in Clinton Twp. We supplement this shipment with your food donations and with food that we purchase from your financial donations. On our three pantry days we pick up free bread from Pepperidge Farm warehouse. We often share our extra bread with another food pantry in Eastpointe.
