A couple months from now I will begin a 3-month sabbatical (April 20 – July 18). I am grateful for the opportunity! A sabbatical is not a 3-month vacation. It will be time of study and prayer as I take an intentional look at the changing demands of pastoral leadership for the 21^{st} century church. A third of my time will be spent in group reflection and coaching. A third will be spent in individual reading, writing, prayer, and planning. The other third will include time of rest and time with family. In total, it will be a chance to go deeper with God, not just for myself, but for the sake of leading Lake Shore Church into the future.

The word sabbatical comes from the biblical word sabbath. The sabbath is a day of religious observance that is set apart from the demands of work. As Christians, our sabbath comes on Sundays, once every seven days. As Pastor, the chance for sabbatical comes once every seven years of ministry (or so). This will be my 8th year at Lake Shore Church and 13th year as a pastor. It will be my first sabbatical.

There never seems to be a great time to take a step away from the demands of the church's life. Not to mention that I will certainly miss all of you. But it is also a needed time. And it is for the sake of the church that I take it. While I am gone, I will be glad to know that I am leaving you in capable hands. The Rev. Isaac Chung will serve as Temporary Pastor during the Sabbatical. Isaac is great and I know you will enjoy him. You will find more about him and his family in this Soundings.

At its best, a sabbatical is time not only for the pastor to grow, but also for the congregation to refresh and recommit herself to the ministry of Christ. It is good for this commitment to happen apart from your pastor. I know you will take full advantage of staying engaged in our Spirit-led ministry and I know the entire church will learn that Lake Shore Church is bigger than the pastor who is leading her.

Sabbaticals for pastors have become very popular across the wider church. Their value has become visible as sabbatical time often leads to new seasons of growth and vitality for both churches and the pastors serving them. I look forward to that promise and to the way that God will use the sabbatical time to take us into the future God desires for us.

But first we have this season of Lent to share together. I will be preaching a series titled "Boot Camp for the Soul." It's a military term but we will use it to consider the various Lenten disciplines that can make this season "hard," and I expect, as we allow ourselves to be pushed, we will find our Lord strengthening us for this Lenten Journey. See you Sunday!
