Ten Ways for Single Saints to Flourish on February 14th

Many single people endure stress during February 14th, the one day the world selects for couples in love to enjoy. It is easy for singles to fall into the trap of feeling isolated during Valentine's Day.

Saved singles can celebrate, too! February 14th is also designated as Singles Awareness Day, a humorous holiday that provides single people with an alternative to Valentine's Day festivities. The S.A.D. acronym suggests that some singles may

be depressed on Valentine's Day, but saved singles know we don't need a significant other to complete us -- our lives are awesome with or without a partner because we are complete in Christ (Colossians 2:10).


